ONSITE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

As in our email sent out this week, the updated School Operations Guide from the Victorian Department of Education & Training shows some changes tovaccination requirements for parents and carers attending all Victorian schools. Parents and carers who enter school buildings must check in using the QR code, as well as adhering to physical distancing, density limits, face mask requirements and pracise respiratory etiquette and good hand hygiene.

Parents and carers who enter school buildings must also have had at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine and must have had two doses of COVID-19 vaccine by 29 November 2021 or have a valid medical exception with limited exceptions for medical reasons or only attending briefly to collect something (please see email for more information).

Parents and carers attending any event or activity inside a school building including, but not limited to tours, graduations, kindergarten transition, whole of school events are required to show evidence of vaccination.

Parents and carers attending school sites for drop off and pick up who do not enter school buildings do not need to comply with vaccination requirements. ENCOURAGING...EQUIPPING...EMPOWERING
