## *From the Principal's Desk*

Through our new Scripture memory passage, we can learn how to love God. Specifically in verses 1-3 we see that we are to love God by obeying his Word. Here, in Moses' first talk to the Israelites, he gives a review of the mighty acts of God (1:1- 4:43). In this second talk, he gives principles for godly living because we must know and act upon God's Word (4:44-29:1). Moses is concerned that when the people move into "the land that floweth with milk and honey" (v. 3), they may forget who blessed them with it as well as their promise to devote themselves in obedience to God's Word.



It is important to "fear" God and keep His commandments. To fear God means to honour and respect Him. If we love God, we should respect Him enough to obey His commands. If we do so, it will go well with us and future generations. So we can see it is important to teach our children, grandchildren, and younger Christians the Word of God and the importance of showing our love for Him by obeying His commands.

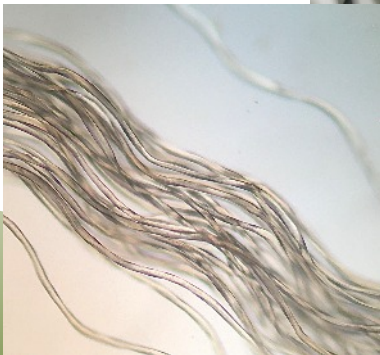
## COLOURING COMPETITION WINNERS!
