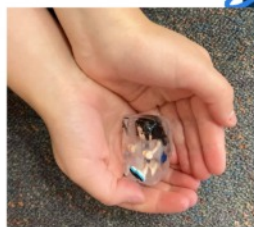
Secondary Students have made a great start to Food Technology, creating some food fit for entertainment, including sushi!
