## From the Principal's Desk



This week, we finish our Scripture memory passage from Romans 10. The last couple of verses remind us of how people come to faith,

"How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, how beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! But they have not all

obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

Sometimes it's hard to imagine that there are people out there who have never heard the gospel message. We tend to think that they live in remote villages. While some do, there are many people who live in our community who have never heard the good news about Jesus. There are people who work with you and maybe even people who live with you who do not know Jesus the way you know Him. Next month we will celebrate Jesus' birth so we have a perfect opportunity to share the gospel message. Faith will only come from hearing the word of God and we may be the only people from whom some may hear the gospel message.








Resonance rehearses on Dja Dja Wurrung, Taungurung and Wurundjeri Country
