MASK/RAPID ANTIGEN SURVEILLANCE TESTING RULE CHANGES

A number of changes to pandemic orders and public health recommendations in Victoria will come into place at 11:59pm on Friday 25 February 2022 that will affect our school. Masks will only be required indoors for students in year 3 or above at primary school, and workers at early childhood centres and primary schools (masks can be removed in secondary school). Masks will also still be required on the school buses.

Rapid antigen surveillance testing will now also continue until the end of Term 1. We have been provided more RATs from the Victorian Government and these will be sent home with students as has previously been done.
