We have begun our second Scripture passage for this term, Romans 10:8-17. In verses 8 to 11, we learn that there is no need for extraordinary means to discover who and what Jesus is. God gave us the message of salvation in the Bible. There is no need for a miracle or any other extraordinary means for a person to become a Christian. His way is through the gospel and the Bible. The message is simple. It is a different kind of righteousness.

Righteousness by faith is very different from righteousness that comes from keeping any kind of rule or set of rules. The plan of salvation does not require us to do what is impossible to do. That would be necessary if we tried to keep the law for salvation. The gospel is only received by faith.

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the

scripture saith, whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed." Romans 10:9-11


