## *From the Principal's Desk*

Verse 3 of our scripture memory section in Philippians Chapter 2 reminds us to fight selfishness and to think less about ourselves and more about the significance of others. We have just past the 80th anniversary of the evacuation of

over three hundred thousand British and allied troops off the beach at Dunkirk during the Second World War. This was largely made possible because of the myriads of British civilians in their small pleasure boats being so unselfish and crossing the English Channel to help carry out the rescue of the trapped soldiers. If they had not displayed such heroic unselfishness, Britain's only trained troops would have been lost and the allied cause would have collapsed and perhaps the whole outcome of the conflict would have been very different.
