This week we began our next Scripture focus. We are learning Proverbs 1:1-9. The writer of this Proverb was King Solomon. Solomon learnt a lot by life experience. Some of his words warn about dangers: "Don't turn this way!" Some of them point to the safe path: "This is the way!" Whatever he found in life he wrote down in Proverbs for the benefit of those who would come after.

It is wonderful, too, at how many points these proverbs touch life, and how intensely practical they are. To consider them and to follow their instruction is to live well.
