MATHS TIMES TABLES

This is one of the most valuable Maths tools for lifeskills and it is so important to know these well. However many students struggle with these until they are effectively memorized.

Parents can assist with this learning by placing a chart on a wall at home and regularly asking students 5 or 6 times tables every day; for example:- 5x6 4x7 9x5 12x6 7x8 until the answers are being given instantly.

Students and their parents will know when they have mastered them, because the answers will be automatic.
